#### **Chairs Report for 2023**

#### **Highlights - Successes**

Chair - Pitch deck from BCS to support reasons on why to become a member. (Membership Benefits) – needs to include RITTech and CITP as well.

Chair – Explained the branch statistics and displayed the current breakdown of membership levels. BCS Pitch deck will be important to help drive membership engagement. Early Career support for students is also important.

The main feedback from the members attending was on the need to try and boost the visibility of BCS within the early careers setting. We need to demonstrate why to become <u>and stay</u> a member of the BCS.

#### Treasurer's report:

Overview: Last year's budget was underspent by approximately 10%

All money held/managed centrally and so not at branch level. No funds are held by committee members.

JW - We need to spend the new budget by close of financial year - so by the end of August 2024

JW – Approved budget for 2024 is £1800

JW – Anything we would like to do we need to decide and get this planned.



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JW – Stoke-on-Tech operates locally and is a significant local 'tech' meetup group and we should look to augment/partner with this more, possibly a summer event.

JW – We spent on GRADEX / Computer Science in Schools June 2023 (Covered under SPF) via Staffordshire University.
